WOOD-BASED INDUSTRY IN REVIEW

The International Tropical Timber Organization (ITTO) stated in its recent Annual Review and Assessment of the World Timber Situation that in 2002 the global tropical timber sector continued to evolve following the trauma of the late 1990s.

China is now becoming a large plywood exporter based on imported logs as the production of plywood by Japan is plummeting. Many producer countries continue their shift to secondary processed products whose exports in 2002 almost rose toward the level of primary tropical timber products trade.

Overall, in ITTO producing countries, log production and log and processed wood exports declined slightly in 2002 relative to the performance in 2000 and 2001. Prices for logs and processed wood products were mix as to the country of origin and of the species.

Specific to the Philippines, preliminary data of the government, mostly, indicated a 31% and 4% decrease in the apparent domestic consumption of logs and primary wood products (lumber, veneer and plywood), respectively, in 2002 compared to the 2001 performance.

Some 57% and 44% of the apparent domestic consumption of logs and of primary wood products, respectively, in 2002 came from imports as against 49% and also 44% of the same in 2001.

Relative to the previous year's, aggregate value exports of logs and primary and downstream wood products slightly improved by 1.5% in 2002 (US\$ 254 million up US\$ 258 million) while imports of the same declined by 2% (US%170 million down US\$ 167 million).

Low GDP growth, budget deficit, slow entry of investments and the residual effects of past regional financial crisis and global political instability ushered in by various wars and terrorism, among others, affected the low albeit flat performance of the wood industry, as of most other industries.

Toward the very end of the year in review, Ms. Elisea G. Gozun was appointed by President Gloria M. Arroyo to replace Mr. Heherson T. Alvarez as the new Secretary of the DENR.

INDUSTRIAL ROUNDWOOD OR LOG SUPPLY

The net supply or apparent domestic consumption (ADC) of logs in 2002 was 31% lower in volume than that in 2001.

The very poor supply of local logs, 42% lower than that of the previous year, was due to either late or none approval of the operations plans of some IFMA and TLA-holders. The shortage was filled up by imported logs, as in the previous year. Imported logs constituted 57% of the 2002 ADC compared to 49% of the 2001 ADC. Table 1 compares the pictures of the above situation.

PRODUCTION, IMPORTATION, AND EXPORT OF PRIMARY WOOD PRODUCTS

The net supply or ADC of aggregate primary wood products in 2002, volumewise, was only 4% lower than in 2001 because of the decline in the local production of lumber, by 23%, and veneer, by 10%, over those in the previous year; while practically maintaining in 2002 level and 2001 the level of their volume import. The 16% hike in plywood production countered the general decline.

However, relative to the performance from the preceding year, the export of the these wood products showed a modest 3% growth. Table 2 illustrates the above situation.

rimary wood products, principally lumber, The inability of the government, esp. DENR, Primary wood products, such as and downstream wood products, such as wood-based manufactured articles and furniture of wood, constituting 9% and 91% of the total value of exports both in 2001 and in 2002, have diversified world markets.

Valuewise, imports were lower by 2% in 2002 than in 2001. In 2002, 96% of the import value was accounted for by logs, lumber and veneer, while wood-based manufactured articles, 4% only; in 2001 respective figures were 98% and 2%.

In 2002, logs were imported from New Zealand, Solomon Islands and Indonesia; lumber, almost entirely from Malaysia, and also from USA; and veneer, generally from Malaysia, and New Zealand.

Table 3 shows the relative balance of trade in wood with the export of high-value added products compensating for the import of input materials such as logs, lumber and veneer.

MAJOR ISSUES FACED

he main issues (see following Major Industry Issues) the wood industry faced during the year under review maybe summarized, thus:

- The continuing if not fluctuating devaluation of the peso against major currencles that affected the import of raw materials;
- The soft demand for, and the dull prices of, finished wood products;

- The reduction of tariff duties and absence Inotalized to every quine as used to safety measures to every one preceding Annual Report, not
 - to address key industry issues that hamper its competitiveness.
 - In general, the creeping growth of the economy aggravated by the long-running political turmoil in southern Philippines.

s always, this year in review, the Association A again elevated the usual concerns of the Industry to the DENR, the Bureau of Customs, the Tariff Commission, the NCIP, etc. as it kept its commitments, as a member, to regional organizations, e.g. APPF and APTO, and to local industry organizations, e.g. PCCI, FPI and ECOP.

DENR Secretary E. G. Gozun has been very attentive to the concerns of the wood industry. In a very short span of time through her stint, she was able to address a number of the major concerns of the industry.

With the survival of the industry, as the uppermost concern, members Association have closed rank in confronting the issues of global competition in general and domestic unfair manufacturing and trade practices in particular. The Plywood Council was very active in putting order to the wood panel sector. Its supply rationalization program (SRP) was successfully implemented. The number of associate members of PWPA has increase by 42% from last year's.

Chair Emeritus Atty. Antonio G. Bernas continues to be active with his counsel the PWPA as its directors and officers as well as members have sustained their cooperation a support, enlightening indeed, the onus of the offices of the Chairman and the President.

MAJOR INDUSTRY ISSUES 2002

ISSUES

POSITION TAKEN BY PWPA

STATUS

Most of the industry issues raised in Year 2001, as contained in the preceding Annual Report, not having been addressed, have remained as continuing issues in Year 2002. They are not anymore repeated/enumerated herein.

A. DENR CONCERN

- 1. Woods operations
- Supply of wood materials from production second growth and plantation forests is not being tapped due to the absence of access policy.
- Poor development of small-sized IFMA, SIFMA and CBFM areas as sources of wood raw materials.
- Harvesting, transport and trading of trees planted in private lands, being regulated through SMF, are found anomalous.
- Intervention of NCIP and/or IP/ICC, invoking IPRA (RA 8371), in TLA/IFMA areas in particular and forestlands in general.

Allow access, through appropriate tenurial instruments and under sustainable forest management, to production second growth and plantation forests in expired TLA areas as additional sources of supply of timber.

Review the programs therefor with the end of view promoting their productive development. The industry could act as 'big brothers'.

Deregulate these practices, even on a trial basis, starting in the Caraga Region, in order to effect a smooth flow of wood materials that benefit all stakeholders concerned.

Claiming priorily tenured forestlands as ancestral domains or lands is not intended by the law. The regulations of NCIP, e.g. AO 2002-3 should be reconciled with existing regulations of DENR.

- 2. Rationalization of the wood processing or manufacturing sectors.
 - Need to update the wood industry rationalization program, in effect since MAO No. 50, Series of 1986, in order to make the wood industry globally competitive.
 - Reviving the sawmill sector by allowing export of lumber manufactured from imported logs.
 - Regulating establishment of new plymills. Idle or low capacity utilization of existing plymills is very evident yet the government continues to allow new plymills to be established contrary to regulations.

A new program of wood industry rationalization would achieve for the sectors concerned the following: revive sawmilling, limit proliferation of the veneer and plywood mills, and effect modernization or retooling of wood mills.

Allowing the export of such lumber is the key to reviving the lumber sector. Millers get back their dollars from export of lumber. More lumber for downstream wood industries. More mills means more employment.

The establishment of new plymills should be based on periodic assessment of the so-called "measured capacity"; i.e., the volume demand by the local and export markets. In this way, the sector becomes competitive.

The proposal is acceptable in principle among key government forester-officials but its operationalization is hesitated due to backlash from environmentalists; yet these forests remain open access to illegal means.

Accordingly, a foreign-funded project is looking how investments maybe attracted, esp. in CBFM, a priority policy of the DENR.

A MOA was signed by and between DENR and PWPA on August 9, 2002 implementing a deregulation exercise in Caraga Region, through an interim Clearing House system.

During the seminar-workshop in October, 2002 in Angeles City between NCIP and PWPA/CMP, areas of concern were discussed. Suggestions from the latter were yet to be studied by the former.

Special Order No. 2001-691 was issued creating the Forest-based Industries Advisory Committee to address issues affecting the wood industry, such as the rationalization program. However, the Committee failed to address the issue.

Export as an approach in minimizing dollar drain and in generating employment is accepted by DENR. The PWPA and FMB are to draft regulations to effect the export mechanism. (Overtaken by change of DENR administration).

The DENR agreed to consider the recommendation, including PWPA's endorsement of application for new plymills - based on a rationalization program. (Overtaken by change of DENR administration).

B. TARIFF COMMISSION, BUREAU OF CUSTOMS, AND DTI/BPS CONCERN.

- Tariff Commission (TC). The TC has continued the accelerated reduction of tariff rates on imported wood articles; through it and in the absence of measures to even the playing field, the wood industry is losing its competitive edge.
- Bureau of Customs. The dumping and smuggling of plywood has caused the price of similar locally made products uncompetitive.
- Bureau of Product Standards. Some plymills, who are not PWPA members, continue to manufacture and sell low quality plywood and even without PS licenses.

TC was asked for a slower if not temporary suspension of tariff reduction, esp. for plywood, under the MFN and AFTA-CEPT agreements. PWPA joined the FPI in urging a congressional action to stay the tariff at the 2001 level.

The Association, by itself, or through the FPI, has called the attention of the BOC and the Department of Trade and Industry about juxtaposed practices.

The Association urged BPS/DTI to intensify the monitoring of, filing charges against, and closing down of these types of erring mills as it asked its members concerned to have PS licenses (see below).

The petition for 2002 tariff at 2001 level failed; however for 2003, tariff will be reverted to 2002 level. PWPA sought government assistance to ease non-tariff barriers imposed by log exporting countries through bilateral arrangement.

The PWPA in PCCI-led import monitoring and the vigilance of its Plywood Council somehow curbed import anomalies. The creation of PPSQF in October 2002 adds force against import malpractices.

To further curb the manufacture and selling of substandard plywood, a MOA between BPS/DTI and DENR, who has power to close down mills, was proposed during the 51st Annual Meeting of PWPA.



1. Corporate Information

Philippine Wood Producers Association, Inc. (the Association) is an association of corporations, partnerships and individuals engaged in logging, sawmilling, veneer and plywood manufacturing, wood preservation, and other related activities. The Association was incorporated as a nonstock, nonprofit corporation which aims to achieve unity in the wood industry under a single integrated association that would serve as spokesman for the entire wood industry in its continuing dialogue with government authorities. Its services, programs and activities are all geared towards the promotion and development of the lumber and plywood industry.

The Association is exempt from the payment of income tax with respect to revenues received in accordance with the provisions of Sec. 30 (f) of the amended National Internal Revenue Code which was passed into law effective January 1, 1998.

The Association had 6 and 7 employees in 2002 and 2001, respectively. The registered office address of the Association is at 3rd Floor, LTA Building, 118 Perea Street, Legaspi Village, Makati City.

2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

Basis of Preparation

The accompanying financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the Philippines.

Adoption of New Accounting Standards

Effective January 1, 2002, the Association adopted Statement of Financial Accounting Standards (SFAS) 16/International Accounting Standards (IAS) 16, Property, Plant and Equipment.

Adoption of this new standard in 2002 did not result in any restatement of prior year financial statements. Additional disclosures required by new standard, however, were included in prior year financial statements, where applicable.

New Accounting Standards Effective Subsequent to 2002

The Accounting Standards Council has approved the following accounting standards which will be effective subsequent to 2002:

- SFAS 37/IAS 37, Provisions, Contingent Liabilities and Contingent Assets, which provides
 the criteria for the recognition and bases for measurement of provisions, contingent liabilities
 and contingent assets. It also specifies the disclosures that should be included with respect to
 these items.
- SFAS 10/IAS 10, Events After the Balance Sheet Date, which prescribes the accounting and disclosures related to adjusting and non-adjusting subsequent events.

The Association will adopt SFAS 37/IAS 37 and SFAS 10/IAS 10 in 2003 and, based on current circumstances, does not believe the effect of adoption will be material.

Membership and Assessment Dues

Membership dues of Timber License Agreement (TLA) holders, sawmillers and associate members are based on monthly fixed rates. Assessment dues of TLA holders are computed based on the annual allowable cuts.

Cash

Cash includes cash on hand and with banks.

Receivables

Receivables are stated at face value less allowance for any doubtful accounts.

Property and Equipment

Property and equipment are carried at cost less accumulated depreciation. Depreciation is computed using the straight-line method based on the estimated useful life of the assets as follows:
